There is a hot tub, which some of the residents use for more than soaking old bones. And there's a sense of community among its occupants, even if the widows wish Howard would keep his suggestive comments — and his hands — to himself. Howard is a busy and a feisty divorcee and a lovely widow are constantly scurrying out of his reach.

The normal routine at Pleasant Valley gets shaken up by the arrival of Lowell and Sybil, a wealthy brother and sister. Sybil is more receptive to the advances of Howard than the other women there, while Lowell quickly connects with Iris, at least when she isn't dashing to the bathroom after accidentally taking a double dose of her diuretic.

There's no mystery here. The audience quickly learns that Lowell and Sybil are con artists looking for elderly rubes to swindle.

With a script heavy on jokes about Viagra, incontinence, and creaky joints, there may not be a single original idea in this show's two acts, but "Senior Follies" delivers pure escapist frivolity and nothing more.
